ZIP-UP TRACK TOP

"Worn with the right pieces, this can be elevated to something really chic. I've paired it with easy-going jeans and some eye-catching sleek red heels. I've layered it with a stripy top – I love how it sits with the stripes down the arms. Don't be afraid of clashing stripes – they're one of the things I play around with the most. Wearing different types together makes an outfit interesting without complicating it."

"A white shirt is a fail-safe that can make any outfit look clean and simple, and it lifts a pair of loose-fit sweatpants. I've styled it off the shoulders, because that's a big trend this year. The black bandeau over the top adds definition and a femininity. I've finished off the look with Converse – you can never go wrong with them. If you're wearing something quite out there, they are totally neutral."

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STIRRUP LEGGINGS

"We first saw these on the Balenciaga AW16 catwalk, and more recently at Giambattista Valli AW17, where models wore Nike leggings. Fashion is trying to bring them back, and I like the idea of a pair of trousers that highlight your shoes. Abandon any idea of wearing them with a tee or sweatshirt, because it'll look as if you've forgotten to take off your gym clothes. Like Balenciaga, I've paired them with a broad-shouldered tweed blazer and stripy shirt, tucked in to keep the look structured. The earrings polish off the look."
